2010 Legacy of Leadership Scholarship

The Bluegrass Alliance for Women will offer an annual \$1,000 non-renewable scholarship each year to women and girls who have demonstrated strong leadership skills and a commitment to volunteer service. The Legacy of Leadership Scholarship is available to female residents of one of the following Bluegrass Areas Development District Counties: Anderson, Bourbon, Boyle, Clark, Estill, Fayette, Franklin, Garrard, Harrison, Jessamine, Lincoln, Madison, Mercer, Nicholas, Powell, Scott, and Woodford. The scholarship is open to women and girls who will be attending college as a full time student or a part time student carrying nine credit hours.

Scholarship Criteria

- 1. To be considered for the Legacy of Leadership Scholarship, the applicant must be a resident of the Bluegrass Area Development District and be one of the following:
 - High school 2010 graduating senior
 - An individual with a General Education Degree (GED) attending college for the first time
 - A currently enrolled college student seeking scholarship funds
 - A non-traditional student going back to college
- 2. One letter of recommendation must be received from organizations supporting volunteer community service (e.g.) Faith-based Outreach, Red Cross, Big Brother/Big Sisters, Salvation Army, Relay for Life, March of Dimes, 4-H, Girls Scouts, Key Club, Beta Club, Student Council, etc. in which the applicant has participated.
- 3. One personal letter of recommendation must be received from a member of the applicant's community who knows the applicant well. (Cannot be from a relative of the applicant).
- 4. Applicants will be required to write and submit an original 250-word essay describing the Applicant's volunteer and/or leadership experience and the applicant's aspirations, goals, or needs as they relate to the BAW mission.
- 5. Scholarship applications will be available on the BAW website (Bluegrassallianceforwomen.com) the first week of October.
- 6. All applications must be post marked by **December 31, 2009**.
- 7. All recipients must present proof of acceptance or enrollment in the appropriate college or university before BAW will submit the check.
- 8. If there are no appropriate applicants or recipients fail to meet the appropriate requirements then the scholarship will not be awarded and the award amount will remain in the scholarship fund for future years.
- 9. The Scholarship Committee will recommend the recipient(s) to the Steering Committee at the January meeting.
- 10. The Steering Committee will hold final approval of the selected scholarship applicants.
- 11. Family members of the Scholarship and Steering Committees are ineligible for that calendar year.
- 12. The scholarship check, made payable to the college or university, will be mailed directly to the college or university Financial Aid Office.
- 13. The scholarships will be officially presented at the Legacy Luncheon.
